## MEET A BENEFICIARY: ROSEME WILSON

My name is Roseme Wilson. I am a married father with 3 children. My wife's name is Maudeline Cerisier. I am among the crop producer group in the IFOSuD Farmer Field School in Bois-Aube, Leogane.

In the past I used to plant crops, but my experience in IFOSUD is totally different. I am more incentivized to work. Recently, I received a pepper seed from friend, and I followed step by step the technical protocol proposed by the IFOSuD agronomist from the soil preparation to the harvest.

By the grace of God, I made a real success in it! I earned enough money from time to time to provide for my family. It's easy for me to make \$100 from the sales of part of the harvest of my peppers. Very often, mostly every Saturday, my wife usually goes to the public market and makes significant revenue just from the sales of peppers. I also grow other crops like plantain, edible sugar cane, and peanuts. I made this garden on less than 400 square meters. Now I am looking for a bigger size of land to farm because **now I know what I am doing, and I am considering myself an entrepreneur.**

I believe any good farmer can make a good living in crop production/sales if you have the right attitude. After my integration in the Farmer Field School of IFOSuD, I have become a strong Christian man thanks to the Christian education program. I regret the time I spent without Jesus in my life.

I have to ask for a favor: my wife, Maudeline Cerisier, is very sick. She already had two surgeries, yet still suffers with pain in her stomach. This ruined my life, but I keep faith in God because He is the Healer of healers. Please, I covet your prayer for my wife so that she can recover her health.
